Public support for, or recommendation of, a particular cause or policy.

- Sackett vs EPA (WOTUS)
- Clean energy development

State

- HB2376 federal government; land acquisition; consent
- HB2377 federal lands; state management costs
- HCM 2006 federal lands; natural resources; permission
- HCM2004 Federal land acquisition; acreage return
- HCM2005 federal lands; transfer to states
- HCM2007 Grand Canyon Footprints monument; repeal
- HCM 2008 Urging Congress; Antiquities Act; repeal
